

Review of Municipal Parking Operations

WHEREAS downtown business have an interest in maintaining the availability of parking on downtown streets and in the downtown municipally-owned parking lots; and

WHEREAS it is prudent for the City to review the operations of all of its services on a regular basis;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that a committee of council be struck consisting of a City Councillor, a member of the Downtown Association, the Manger of Transit and Parking and the Director of Planning in order to review parking operations in Sault Ste. Marie's downtown.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee make recommendations to Council as to what changes, if any, should be implemented by Council with respect to parking operations in Sault Ste. Marie's downtown.
