NO SUBSTANTIAL WORKS ON ARTERIAL ROADS AT RUSH HOUR

WHEREAS 8:00 a.m. – 9:30 a.m. are the morning office rush hour times on City streets; and

WHEREAS 4:30 p.m. – 6 p.m. are the evening office rush hour times on City streets; and

WHEREAS any impeding of traffic at these times amplifies the congestion on the City streets; and

WHEREAS arterial roads are used by most residents to arrive to-and-from any destination in the City at all hours of the day, but in higher volumes during the morning and evening rush hours; and

WHEREAS in recent months, both line painting and resurfacing have been undertaken on these arterial roads during the morning and evening rush hours, amplifying traffic congestion;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT any future City contracts awarded for construction works on arterial roads specify that, to the greatest degree possible, traffic not be impeded during the morning or evening rush hours set out herein as long as the restrictions have no more than a minimal impact on the overall cost of the road works.
