WHEREAS the City of Sault Ste. Marie has a process in place to dispose of surplus

land; and

WHEREAS the City's policy on the disposition of surplus land does not take into consideration whether the property is a small parcel of land, or a developable parcel of land in determining how to market the surplus land; and

WHEREAS developable parcels of land can draw greater interest if advertised through professional realtors; and

WHEREAS any parcel of land in excess of 400 m² should be considered developable;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT City staff, with input from the Sault Ste. Marie Real Estate Board be requested to develop a policy whereby surplus City land is advertised for sale with local realtors in order to maximize the value for taxpayers in the sale of said land; and

FURTHER THAT the surplus property by-law be reviewed as part of this process and reported to Council.
